## **Team Leaders**

- 1. Please read the risk assessments and sign them off.
- 2. Please ensure team members are aware of and abide by relevant sections of policies and risk assessments.
- 3. Make sure that equipment is set up properly, particularly in high winds.
- 4. If there is an incident, please complete an incident report form (see leader's folder) and follow the instructions given. These are important for the safety of future missions.

## **Everyone**

- 1. Health & Safety is everyone's responsibility! Please read the 'Health & Safety Policy' which is available at the centres and online (<a href="http://www.files.ubm.org.uk/docs/ubm-health&safety-policy.pdf">http://www.files.ubm.org.uk/docs/ubm-health&safety-policy.pdf</a>).
- 2. Team members are expected to comply with all safety instructions. Should you have concerns that anything you are asked to do is unsafe, please raise it with your team leader.
- 3. No children should be taken into the sea.
- 4. Apply sun cream, wear a hat and drink plenty of water when outside (even on cooler days). Sunburn happens by stealth especially when sitting in the same position!
- 5. Ensure that you know how to get out of HQ in the event of fire (be careful about leaving electronic items plugged in).
- 6. Ensure good hygiene is maintained in the a) kitchen, b) bathroom, c) communal areas.
- 7. Make sure you tell someone where you are, even in your free time
- 8. Alcohol, tobacco or drugs use is not allowed.
- 9. Take care with manual handling.
- 10. Always be mindful of members of the public and behave responsibly.
